Wastebuster has been delivering its local authority waste education programme since 2008 to address the significant challenges in developing and delivering strategies to reduce waste. With a combined network of over 17,800 registered schools in the UK, Wastebuster is one of the largest network providers of environmental education.

Working with local authorities, Wastebuster help communities take practical action to reduce material, energy, carbon and water waste to help mitigate against climate change. Delivering annualised campaigns and offering high-quality education resources for the classroom on energy, waste, water, biodiversity, climate science and a range of other environmental topics, with a particular focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). Wastebuster also specialise in engaging, informing, and inspiring children and young people to carry their learning beyond the school gates, so they might activate positive change in the home.

All Pod resources are curriculum linked and aimed at 4 - 16-year-olds. With lesson plans, practical activities, campaign toolkits, waste and energy audits, assemblies, films, games, and information packs as well as posters, stickers, and badges and enriching home learning activities, that engage the whole family.

The Wastebuster local authority service contract recognises the need to be responsive to local needs, to effectively tackle unique local challenges and support positive attitude and behaviour change in local communities. Wastebuster's annualised, industry funded, cross-sector supported campaigns on its multi-award-winning platform, the Pod include Switch-Off Fortnight, Waste Week, What's Under Your Feet? in association with BBC Countryfile, Recycle to Read and (coming soon) Water Week have assisted over 200 UK local authorities to help schools, parents, and their local community to engage with important sustainability issues since 2008.
